Hello,

My name is Maria and I am 10 years old. I live in Curahuasi, in the Andes mountains of Peru.

Our house is made out of mud bricks with a dirt floor. Our whole house has only two rooms where I live with my mother, step-father and my siblings. My father left our family and we don't see him anymore. My mother and step-father both work as farm laborers but it is not a secure job.

I like to read and I am looking forward to attending the Diospi-Suyana School because I know I'll be able to learn a lot there.

## Sponsor a child to attend Diospi Suyana's School

Life in Curahuasi can be complicated. Although there are a few middle-class families, there are many more families like Mary's that are struggling just to feed their children. Single parent families are very common as are families dealing with alcoholic fathers and domestic violence situations. In many local schools teachers often arrive late to work or even don't show up at all. Here in Curahuasi children sometimes have to grow up fast with many living in situations where they need to care for younger brothers and sisters or take on household responsibilities even when they are very young.

It is the dream of Diospi Suyana to offer a brighter future for as many of these children as possible. We plan to incorporate the local Quechua culture including the native language in our day-to-day classes.



Our desire is to find sponsors for some of the poorest children of Curahuasi in order to allow them to attend our school which offers an international standard of education and learning - something that would normally be reserved for only the wealthiest families in this country. Our hope is that by providing a quality education to some of the most disadvantaged children we will be giving them an opportunity to lift themselves out of the poverty cycle.

Even more important than the high standard of education that will be offered at the school, every child will get the opportunity to hear about their Creator and learn about what Jesus Christ has done for them. Our desire is that each child will develop a personal relationship with Jesus and therefore bring a positive influence over their families and in the town itself.

Additionally, Diospi Suyana plans to hold parenting seminars and home visits, thus including the entire family in this work of transformation.

Anyone who decides to sponsor a child in this worthy project will have the opportunity to establish personal contact with the child they are sponsoring. Every sponsor will

receive a photo of the student as well as information regarding their education and school life. There is even the possibility of exchanging correspondence between the sponsor and child.

Diospi Suyana will assist with any necessary translation. In the unlikely situation that a sponsored child's own family becomes able to financially support the student, Diospi Suyana will advise the sponsor of this change in the circumstances. However, even if this is the case, sponsors having provided a valuable start in that child's education, will be able to continue contact with the student, if this is desired.

Diospi Suyana is a non-denominational, evangelical, non-profit organization with projects including a hospital, children's clubs and a school in the Peruvian Andes mountains. It relies heavily on foreign donations from individuals, churches and companies. All donations to Diospi Suyana are subjected to an independent audit on yearly basis.
